

COVID-19 Exposure Protocols and Procedures

Social responsibility is critical to slowing the spread of COVID-19. If you have close contact, questionable exposure, or symptoms, **it is imperative to speak up.**

Contact Tracing

- **Exposure:** A *primary* exposure occurs when someone is within six feet of a positive case for at least 15 minutes. A *secondary* exposure occurs when someone has close contact with a primary exposure.
- **Close Contact:** A person is considered in “close contact” if s/he was within six feet of the positive case, for 15 minutes or longer. Multiple factors will be discussed and considered when identifying who needs to quarantine.

Self-Monitoring

Sample Scenarios

What if ...	Can I come to camp?	Who should I call?
I have been tested for COVID and do not have results yet?	No , do not come to camp. results. Consult the school nurse to be cleared to return.	Camp Office: 918-495-1111.
I tested positive for COVID-19?	No , remain at home to isolate for a minimum of 10 days from the onset of symptoms, must be fever-free for a minimum of 72 hours before returning to camp.	Camp Office: 918-495-1111 to trace any possible CS connections.
Someone in my household has a COVID-19 test pending?	No , remain home to monitor symptoms / await test results.	Camp Office: 918-495-1111 to trace any possible CS connections.
Someone in my household has tested positive for COVID-19?	No , remain at home to quarantine for 14 days* and self-monitor for symptoms. <i>*Note: the length of time may be longer depending on exposure.</i>	Camp Office: 918-495-1111 to trace any possible CS connections.
I was in close contact (within six feet for 15 minutes or longer) with someone experiencing symptoms and/or tested positive of COVID-19?	No , quarantine yourself at home for 14 days and monitor for symptoms.	Camp Office: 918-495-1111 to trace any possible CS connections.
I was in close contact with a coworker, friend, or casual contact (within six feet for 15 minutes or longer) who had a friend with whom s/he was in close contact who tested positive for COVID-19?	Yes , you may return to campus. You will continue to self-monitor for symptoms for 14 days.	No need to contact camp unless you become ill.
