

Campers 1st-10th Grade

LABEL all items

MASK: Your camper will need to wear a mask when less than 6 feet physical distance. Also when dropping off and picking up campers. Walking down the hall.

Home Base/Group: Each specialist camp will have their own home base/group.

What to bring:

- Campers are encouraged to wear their swim suit to camp.
- Bring a change of clothes, towel, sunscreen, non meat lunch and a filled water bottle.

Lunch:

Groups will eat lunch in their designated outdoor area, when weather allows. When eating inside, campers will be spread out 6'.

- **MUST** bring lunch, that does **NOT** require a microwave, Camp Shalom will **NOT** provide lunch this summer with the exception of Friday Pizza.

Swimming: Will have free swim daily.

- **1st-10th Grade Swim test:**

- The swim test will determine your campers swim bracelet color. Green bracelets are allowed to go anywhere in the big pool and will have a buddy. The yellow bracelets will be allowed in the smaller pool and only in the bigger pool in a small group with a counselor. Red bracelets will be with counselors on the steps of the pool. Please help your camper keep their bracelet on for the week. If campers do not want to take a swim test, a red bracelet will be given. For particular questions or concerns about your child's swim test, please talk with the head lifeguard, 918-495-1111

Stop, Drop and Read: 1st-10th grade groups will have a stop, drop and read time for 20 minutes each day. We encourage parents to send their summer reading books, we will also have books of all levels and camper interest.

Electronics: Do not send any electronics.

Before care Drop Off: 7:30am-8:15am

- Parents will park in the big parking lot and walk campers to the building-
- Camp Staff will meet you at JCC front desk.

Camp Hour Drop Off: 8:15am-8:45am

- Park in the big parking lot and walk campers to their group located in the circle drive grass area.
- Staff will have the name of the group on the clipboard.

Camp Pick up: 4:15-4:45

- Campers will be in front of JCC in the circle drive grass area- parents will park in the big parking lot and walk to pick up campers.
- Staff will have the name of the group on the clipboard.

After Car Pick Up: 4:45-6:00pm

- Park in the big parking lot, walk to JCC front door- camp staff use walkie talkie after care for your camper to come up front.

Will campers be required to wear masks?

Masks are required by campers/staff while inside the building. Masking will not be worn when: while eating, drinking, swimming, 3-K nap time, outside play and when social distance is possible.

Zarrow Campus:

Camp Shalom will use the Zarrow Campus. Each group (POD) will have their own home base. Each POD will have the same counselors and specialists all week. Campers will be outside more than we have been in the last 20 years. Zarrow Campus has an amazing outdoor space- sports complex, numerous parks, walking trails, garden, shaded benches.

Camp Shalom Balance: Each week's balance needs to be paid before attending on Monday morning. Please log into your online account to make payment.

Before and After Care: Campers must be signed up for the full week for before and after care.
